Week 16-- John Chapter 13 Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet

Outline

- I. Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet (vss. 1-17)
 - a. Before The Feast of the Passover and after Supper had ended
 - b. Jesus rose from supper, laid his outer garment to the sign, took a towel, and girded Himself (vs 4)
 - c. He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciple's feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded (vs 5)
 - d. Jesus teaches Peter about the significance of Him washing his feet (vss. 6-10)
 - e. Jesus sets the example for being a servant leader (vss 11-17)
- II. Jesus Betrays His Betrayer (vss 18-35)
 - a. The dipping of bread was a sign of honor. Jesus uses it to identify his betrayer. What Judas thought was a sign of honor was to be the revealing of his shame (vs26)
- III. The New Commandment (vss 31-35)
 - a. Vs 34 a new commandment: Love one another
 - b. Vs 35: "By this will all know that you are my disciples, that you have love for one another
- IV. Jesus Predicts Peter's Denial (vss 36-38)
